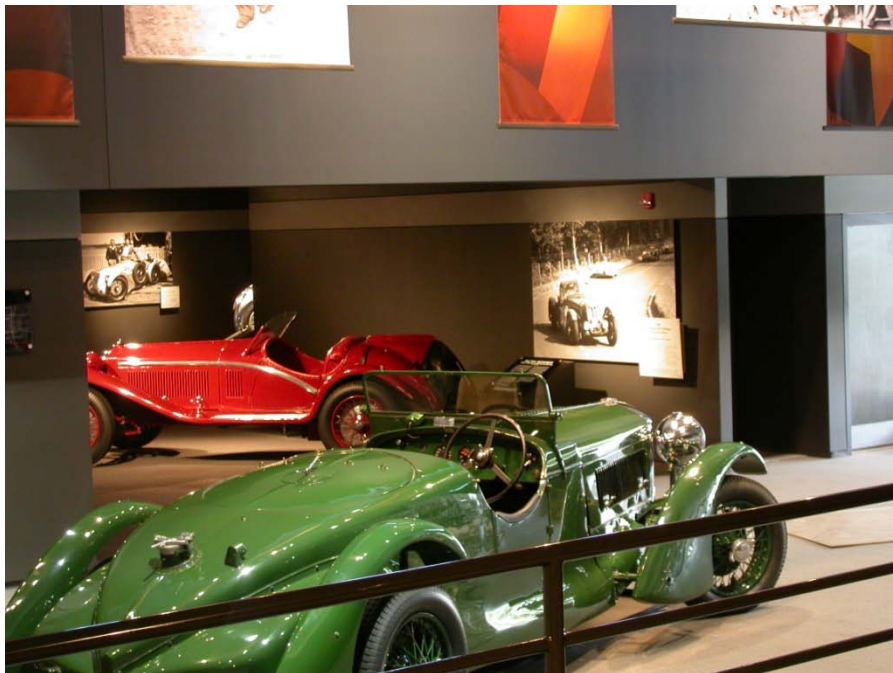

The Collier Collection comprises over 100 automobiles manufactured between 1898 and 1995. The focus of the collection is to preserve those machines defined by their social, technical and aesthetic significance. Thus, the collection's holdings encompass some of the most extraordinary and relevant automobiles in this lofty class. The Collier Collection is in the vanguard in appreciating the importance of preserving automobiles in their original, untouched and patinated state, an important trend in artifact exhibits. With few deliberately considered exceptions, the automobiles in the collection are fully operational.



## DIRECTIONS TO COLLIER AUTOMOTIVE MUSEUM

### FROM I-75:

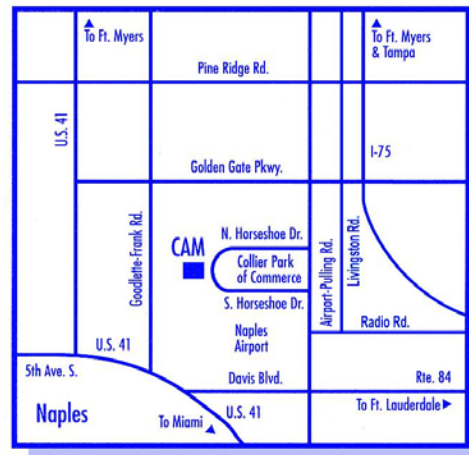
- **I-75 to Exit 105 toward Golden Gate/Naples**
- **Head West onto Golden Gate Parkway stay to the right; do not take overpass (1.9 miles)**
- **Turn left on Airport Pulling Road (0.9 mile)**
- **Turn right on Horseshoe Drive (0.5 mile)**
- Follow Horseshoe Drive until it starts to bend to the left, at which point there is a vacant field on the right. We're just next to the field (#2500) on the right. There is no sign, just the number on the driveway. Large grey building. Please use main front entry doors.

### FROM NORTH NAPLES:

- **South on Route 41** to Coastland Center Mall
- **Left on Golden Gate Parkway**
- **Right on Airport Pulling Road (4<sup>th</sup> light)**
- **Right on Horseshoe Drive (3<sup>rd</sup> light – you're turning into the Collier Park of Commerce)**
- Follow Horseshoe until it starts to bend to the left. Pass a vacant field and we're the first building on the right past the field. There is no sign, just a number (2500) by the first driveway. Please enter through the front doors.

### FROM DOWNTOWN NAPLES:

- Start out of town heading east on Route 41
- Turn **left** on **Davis Boulevard**
- Turn **left** on **Airport Pulling Road**
- Pass Naples Municipal Airport and turn **left** onto **South Horseshoe Drive**. Note that Horseshoe has 2 entrances; you want to take the second, which is at a traffic light.
- Follow Horseshoe until it starts to bend to the left. Pass a vacant field and we're the first building on the right past the field. There is no sign, just a number (2500) by the first driveway. Please enter through the front doors.
