Please find below the decision of the FIDE Council in respect of the situation with the Royal Moroccan Chess Federation, for your kind information and follow-up:

The Council, upon studying the situation with RMCF experiencing various difficulties and controversies since 2016 and after studying all relevant material provided from RMCF relating to such controversies, including judicial cases and other disputes, hereby resolves as follows:

1. To thank the FIDE Reverse Delegate Victor Bologan for the successful accomplishment of his mission and to terminate the mandate of the FIDE reverse delegate for RMCF, this way all rights and duties, related to FIDE membership, will be back to a fully recognized RCMF;
2. To confirm that FIDE recognizes the following office of RCMF (as of the date of this Resolution):

3. To recommend RCMF to assure the continuity of the successful practices of the FIDE Reverse delegates, especially for in what concerns the registration of tournaments, norms and players;
4. To recommend RCMF to pay special attention to consent and encourage the affiliation of all chess clubs and associations active in Morocco, avoiding any discrimination;
5. To nominate a “FIDE special envoy”, for one year, charged to monitor and report on compliance of the RMCF with the federation’s statutes and FIDE Charter (incl. proactive registration of tournaments, norms and players), and to assign Mr. Battikh Tahar (TUN), the former member of the FIDE Council, for this position.
